The **UK Diabetic Foot Congress** brings together leading clinicians, researchers and healthcare professionals to share the latest evidence, innovations and best practice in diabetic foot care. Through a comprehensive programme of lectures, panel discussions and debates, the Congress explores national perspectives on diabetic foot disease, multidisciplinary approaches to care, health inequalities, emerging technologies and the economic impact of diabetic foot complications.

The inaugural **2026 UK Diabetic Foot Congress** attracted **over 170 delegates** from across the UK. Representatives attended from **more than 60 hospitals and trusts**, with delegates travelling from locations including London, Manchester, Leeds, Sheffield, Liverpool, Birmingham, Norwich, Belfast, Edinburgh and Jersey.
